Your unit is asked to pick up the filled Scouting for Food bags from the neighborhoods on Saturday, October 24, 2009. Your unit will then deliver the food items to your local food pantries, soup kitchens and food banks.

If your unit participates on Oct. 24<sup>th</sup> and carries on this great cause, we ask that your Pack, Troop, Venturer or Exploring Post submits your service hours to the Good Turn for America website at [goodturnforamerica.org](http://goodturnforamerica.org), then on the home page click “Tell us about your service project,” and click to log your unit’s hours.
